# Getting started with **libby**

The Libby app is a new, one-tap reading app for borrowing digital books and audiobooks from your library.

**Install** the Libby app from the app store on your Android, iOS (iPhone, iPad, iPod touch), or Windows 10 device.

In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library. **Search For A Library** using the zip code **54017**.



You can search for your library by name or branch location.

## TIPS

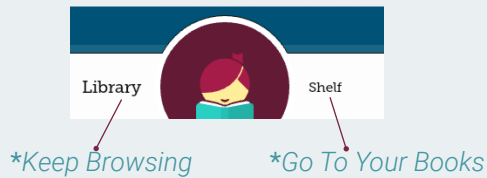
Borrowed titles appear on your **Shelf** and download to the app automatically when you're on Wi-Fi so you can read them when you're offline.

From your **Shelf**, you can:

- Tap **Open Book**, **Open Audiobook** or **Open Magazine** to start reading or listening.
- Tap **Manage Loan** to see options like **Renew**, **Return**, or **Send to Device** to send a book to Kindle (U.S. Libraries only).

**Easy Navigation:** at the bottom of the page you can keep browsing or find the titles you have checked out on your shelf.



**Managing Titles:** tap a cover image in your shelf for options to open the book, renew it, return it to the library, or send it to Kindle.

**Search Preferences:** tap the **+** to open the preferences to narrow your search. Tap the **search bar** and then tap **More** to open advanced search options such as format, subjects, special titles, and date added.
